Momjian wins first Lucas Oil Super Comp title, Richardson takes first win of season



Richardson stops Kirby—Moves into Series Points Contention

John Richardson went to his second Lucas Oil Super Comp Assoc. final round of the season where he paired off with Glenn Kirby, also a two time finalist, with Richardson getting the win and moving into contention for the 2006 Lucas Oil Super Comp championship.

Fifty-three cars entered the Lucas Oil-Rebrovich Family Racing-sponsored seventh race of the season, with Chris Forsyth qualifying number one, Shannon Chennault added to her Top

Qualifier series points lead by qualifying second, and Rob Symons qualified third.

Defending series champion Bobby Dye Jr. opened the third round with an 8.899 win over Tom McBride, Val Torres Jr. defeated Robert Momjian, race #5 winner Glenn Kirby stopped points challenger Charlie Waggoner Jr., Sam Boyd defeated Robert



Naber, Ryan Tietz beat John Boyd, Richardson ran an 8.909 to defeat John Dewald, and Larry Madrid edged Bobby Mirizio in a double break-out race.



Sam Boyd opened the quarterfinals with a win over Dye Jr. 8.902 to an 8.893, Kirby used a .004 light to beat Tietz, Torres Jr. and Madrid both ran identical 8.910 times with .018 reaction times with Torres Jr. getting the win light, and Richardson got a bye.

In the semifinals, Kirby went to his second final round in three races when he clocked an 8.907 for the win as Torres Jr. broke-out, and Richardson advanced with an 8.914 and .004 r.t. as Boyd lost with an 8.931 (.013 r.t.)

Both Richardson and Kirby left the line with nearly identical reaction times--.028 for Richardson and .029 for Kirby—but the win light came on for Richardson as he logged an 8.905, 166.81 for the win as Kirby settled for second with an 8.914, 164.99. Richardson thanks his wife Roni, Lucas Oil, Carroll Shelby Goodyear Tires, Steve Schmidt Racing Engines, ATI Transmissions, JE Pistons, Ron's Fuel Injection, C.L. Bryant VP Racing Fuels, and Crow Enterprises for his successful season.

Jim Momjian wins first Lucas Oil Super Comp event—Mandy Quigley settles for runner-up honors

It was only a matter of time before Jim Momjian—or one of his RGM Motors team cars—won a Lucas Oil Super Comp Assoc. event. That time came at the 8th race of the 2006 season when Jim defeated Mandy Quigley in the final round at Auto Club Dragway at California



Speedway.

Forty-eight cars entered the Lucas Oil and American Exterminators sponsored race—the 8th race on the 10-race schedule—with John Boyd qualifying number one with a perfect 8.900, Robert Momjian was second at 8.901, and Shawn Langdon was third with an 8.902.

Jim Momjian made his way to the final round by defeating top qualifier Boyd in the first round, in round two he stopped Saturday's winner, Richardson, after both drivers recorded .008 reaction times, but Richardson broke-out by .007. In the third round, Momjian beat Justin Davis, he beat Glenn Kern in the quarterfinals 8.916 to an 8.915, and he got a bye into the final.

Mandy Quigley drove the Quigley Girls dragster to her first final of the season, as she beat Brian Calvin in round one; Larry Madrid in the second round and Chris Forsyth in round three. Quigley recorded a perfect .000 reaction time in the quarterfinals to beat Jeff Murdock 8.905 to an 8.881. In the semifinals she defeated Val Torres as he broke-out by .001.



Momjian and Quigley went to the final round with both drivers looking for their first win of the season. Momjian cut the better reaction time--.009 to a .037—and got the win with an 8.920, 168.68 to a runner-up effort of 8.924, 167.86. Momjian credits RGM Motors, Rosa Maria's Mexican Restaurants, K & N Filters, and Lucas Oil for their support.

With the final points races set for September 16, and a non-points race on Sept. 17 at Auto Club Dragway, Danny Aguayo has 447 points for the series lead, with Danny Fuentes second with 438 followed by John Richardson with 434 and Shawn Langdon with 432.

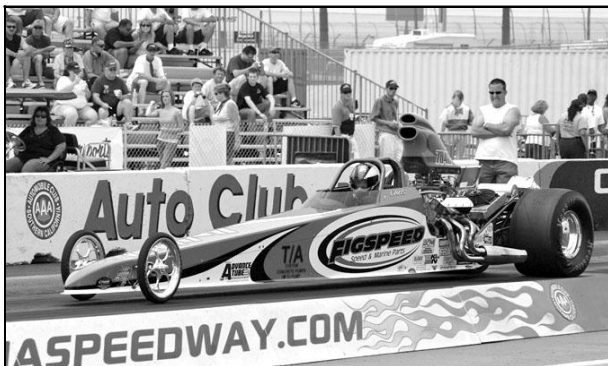
