Josh Newton wins Famoso Raceway Super Comp Bash

Josh Newton won for the first time in the Lucas Oil-K&N Filters Super Comp Assoc., series, as he defeated Eddie Fischle in the final round at the famed Auto Club Famoso Raceway north of Bakersfield.

Mike Boner drove his '96 Olds to the top qualifying spot for the Saturday race, the 7th of the 2008 10 race series.

Third round racing began with Eddie Fischle defeating Will Mangrum, Garrett Wiles .011 light held off John Richardson, Newton posted a .005 light to stop Ed Krzywick, Ray Medrano beat Clayton Zulim and Corey LeClair got a bye.

LeClair got a pass to the semifinals as Wiles had to shut-off with a water leak, Newton advanced when Medrano fouled, and Eddie Fischle got a bye to the semi.

In the semifinal, Fischle ran an 8.897 with a .002 light to beat LeClair at 8.884 with a .028 light. Newton got a bye to the final.

Newton picked up his first association race win with an 8.911, 160.04 (.020 reaction time) in the final round as Fischle cut a .012 light, but was .021 too quick with an 8.879, 168.85. The win wasn't the first in his dragster, as he won the KD Kanopy Shootout race at Phoenix earlier this year.

Matt Fischle has a stack of trophies from the Junior Drag Racing League, but he scored his first Super Comp dragster win at Auto Club Famoso Dragway, as he defeated Rob Flory in



the final round.

Robert Kenyon logged his first number one qualifier honor at the event, but had the misfortune of losing in the first round.

In the second round of eliminations, Gallo Shootout front-runner George Garbiso posted an 8.903 to defeat Bobby Dye Jr., Dan Blackwell red-lighted to Flory, Fischle stopped Don Barton, and points leader Chris Forsyth beat Chuck Babcock. Rob Symons got a bye.

Garbiso opened the quarterfinals with a win over Rob Symons, Fischle stopped Forsyth in an 8.906 to 8.946 battle after both racers posted .036 reaction times. Flory got the bye into the semifinal.

Garbiso and Flory paired up in the semifinals, with Garbiso going red by .001 and 8.920 time.

Flory won with an 8.956. Fischle ran an 8.902 on his single into the final.

Flory, the runner-up in race five at Fontana and Fischle met in the final round with Fischle getting the win with an 8.918 and .021 reaction time, as Flory was .004 too quick, losing with an 8.896.
