2007 RGM Motorsports "Top Qualifier" & Shoot-Out Rules

1. The **RGM Motorsports "Top Qualifier"** program is open to anyone who participates in the Lucas Oil / Super Comp Association scheduled races of the 2007 season.
2. The Shoot-Out race will be co-sponsored by: **Lucas Oil Products**, and **K&N Filters**.
3. The points earned during qualifying will be tallied throughout the season, these points will no longer be applied to round points, (see general rules) and the racer with the highest total overall from the **9 scheduled races**, (not including the Last Sunday race) will earn the purse. It's the racers responsibility to verify the points listed in the newsletter, or web site are correct, you have 30 days to notify the association. Otherwise any error in points will stand as is. The program will pay out all eight competitors. The point system will be the same as the Big Bud Shoot-Out, see NHRA Rulebook page 251.
4. All contestants must run the **RGM Motorsports** decal, the **Lucas Oil**, and **Sunoco Racing Fuels** decals throughout the season. All decals shall be applied in a predominant place, visible in all photographic angles.
5. In the event that there is a tie, the ladder positions will be determined by this **First Rule**, the total points will be divided by the amount of races attended. **Second**, in the event there is still a tie, the racer who has qualified the lowest (Closer to number one) will be declared ahead of the other(s). **Third**, a flip of a coin from the race director will be the final run order.
6. Replacement car, shall a contestant's car be unable to continue in the qualifying for the number one, or other positions, a replacement car is valid. A replacement car can be substituted in Qualifying, not eliminations, providing it has passed tech, and the Driver's number is applied to the racecar in a clean fashion, shoe polish will not be accepted as a temporary applied numbering.
7. The Champion, Runner-Up, and Semi Final purses will be paid at the season ending Championship Awards Banquet only. You must attend to receive payment. The fifth place through eighth place will be paid at the event that day.
8. The final top four qualifiers will have lane choice for the first round of eliminations only, and each round their after will be the flip of the coin rule.
