**Murdock Opens 2008 Lucas Super Comp Series with a win,
Boner takes Race #2 and series lead at Auto Club Dragway**



Murdock Captures Lucas Oil Super Comp Victory at Auto Club Dragway

Jeff Murdock opened the 2008 Lucas Oil Super Comp Association season with a final round win over '07 Rookie of the Year Andrew Madrid at Auto Club Dragway. Murdock got his win the hard way, as he needed to do an engine change prior to eliminations.

Murdock had a tough beginning of the season and weekend with his dragster, as he broke on engine on his first qualifying attempt of the day. Fortunately, with a large turnout of racecars at Auto Club Dragway, Murdock replaced the engine and was ready for first round and proceeded to win the event.

Tom McBride of Lakeside, Calif., earned the number one qualifying position with a perfect

8.900, followed by John Richardson (8.902), and Dick Krieger (8.903). Seven of the 57 entries qualified on the 8.90 index.

Murdock defeated Ronnie Lahn in the first round, he ran an 8.911 in the second round to beat Michael Gidcumb in round two, he used a .009 light in round three to beat Las Vegas racer Dick Krieger, and in round four he stopped Melissa Quigley 8.914 to an 8.877. Murdock's .007 starting line advantage and 8.915 in the semi defeated Eddie Fischle with a too quick 8.873.

Race runner-up Andrew Madrid earned the Lucas Oil Super Comp "Rookie of the Year" honor after winning twice in '07 and finishing third in the series final standings last year. Madrid began his path to the final by defeating Harold Meziere in the first round, he cut a .011 light to beat Vince Campa in round two, and stopped former series champ Bobby Dye Jr., in round three. Madrid got by the Pacific High Reach-sponsored dragster of Justin Davis in a double-breakout race in the quarterfinals 8.863 to an 8.851, and in his semi he edged Michael Piraino, also in a double-breakout contest, 8.874 (.012 r.t.) to a losing 8.868 (.008 r.t.).

Murdock was on his game in the final, using a .007 reaction time and 8.894, 159.70 to beat Madrid as he lost with an 8.853, 164.35 (.047 reaction time).

Murdock will go into the May 31st event in second place in the series standings, with Madrid in fourth place.



2007 Lucas Oil Super Comp Assoc., "Rookie of the Year" Andrew Madrid made another impressive showing at the series opening weekend, finishing runner-up to Jeff Murdock in race #1. Andrew is 4th in the series standings and in the top ten of the Gallio Motorsports Shootout standings.

Mike Boner stops Morgan Rash for event win, Series points lead.

Mike Boner of Riverside, Calif., had a big day at Fontana, picking up the winner's check for the Sunday Super Comp event, the number one qualifying position, and the Lucas Oil Super Comp series points lead. Boner, whose popular '88 Ford Thunderbird was destroyed in a crash last year, replaced the Ford with a Cutlass shortly after the crash and enjoyed his first victory with the new car at Auto Club Dragway.

Boner qualified with a perfect 8.900—based on his first round win as qualifying was curtailed because of time restrictions on Sunday—with his Olds. Chad Langdon's Clay Smith Cams-sponsored dragster was second with an 8.902, and Doug Crumlich's Mickey Thompson Tires-backed Corvette was third with an 8.906.

After running a perfect 8.900 in the first round of eliminations, Boner got a bye in the second round, beat Don Meziere in round three 8.947 to an 8.977. He stopped Raymond Medrano in round four 8.929 to a losing 8.902, and in the semifinals Doug Crumlich's Corvette had a .001 advantage off the line, but was too quick at 8.896 to a winning 8.935.

Morgan Rash advance to the final with his dragster with a double breakout win over Paul

Wiechmann, he stopped Matt Fischle's Lucas dragster in round 2, and used a .008 light to stop former champ Bobby Dye Jr. in round 3. Rash beat Chad Langdon in the quarters 8.914 to an 8.887 before getting a bye in the semi where he posted a .012 light and 8.910 on the single.

In the final round, Boner had a better light by .026 seconds, and held on for the win with an 8.904, 168.66 to Rash's losing 8.898, 162.47.

Mike Boner thanks his wife Robin, Randy Kersey, and Kevin Drew for their support and credits them for making this win happen. He also expressed appreciation to Jack DeRencin, Lucas Oil, Auto Club of Southern California, and K&N Filters for making this series possible. Sponsors for Boner include Munsinger Converters, Mike's Transmissions, Team C Performance, Hot Rod Performance, and Ray Zeller Horsepower.

The Lucas Oil Super Comp series continues at Auto Club Dragway at California Speedway on May 31-June 1 for the third and fourth races of the season. Boner will take the series points lead into the contest with 156 points, followed by Jeff Murdock (132), Michael Pirano (122), Andrew Madrid (113), Mandy Quigley (113), and Morgan Rash (112). Chad Langdon and Doug Crumlich are tied for seventh with 105 points, and Eddie Fischle and Bobby Dye Jr. are tied for ninth with 102 points.

The Gallio Motorsports Shootout points contest has Tom McBride leading with 175, John Richardson is next with 165, and Dick Krieger is third at 155.
