Reigning Champ Danny Aguayo defeats Rob Flory for Race 5 title at Fontana

Reigning Lucas Oil/K&N Filters Super Comp Association series champion Danny



Danny Aguayo and Rob Flory had a tough battle in the Race 5 final, with Aguayo getting the win at 8.904 to Flory's too quick 8.899.

Aguayo won for the first time this season, moving him solidly into the top ten in points with four events remaining on the '08 schedule. The race was an emotion-filled event for the Aguayo Family, as it was the first race they've entered since the passing of long-time friend, co-racer, and sponsor Dave Symons.

Matt Fischle earned the Auto Club of Southern California low qualifier award, putting a perfect 8.900 on the scoreboards

with his Fischle Printing & Lucas Oil-sponsored dragster. John Richardson's 8.901 was good for second, and Chris Forsyth was third at 9.903. Quarterfinal action began with Aguayo advancing with a .006 advantage in a double-breakout race, Rob Flory ran a perfect 9.900 to stop Guy Aguayo, losing with a 9.906, and Forsyth was good by .003 to stop Tom McBride who broke out. Aguayo and points contender Forsyth met in the semi with Aguayo taking the double-breakout, 8.893 to an 8.890.

Aguayo and Flory—both first time finalists this year—matched up for the series fifth event title win of the season with Aguayo getting a .011 advantage at the starting line, and holding on for the win light at 8.904, 16.43 to Flory's losing

8.899, 153.42.

Val Torres Jr., continues summer hot streak with win over Sarah Kelso

Val Torres Jr., has had a remarkable summer this year, winning the Top Sportsman title at the Fallon, Nev., Lucas Oil Drag Racing Series event, he was the runner-up in Super Gas at the Fram-Autolite Nationals, and won the Super Gas title at the Sonoma LODRS. Torres

kept his hot streak going with the Sunday Lucas Oil-K&N Filters Super Comp Association event title at Fontana.

Joey Trotsky took the AAA low qualifier award on Sunday with an 8.900. Don Barton matched the time for the second spot, and Ray Medrano and Guy Aguayo (driving a brand-new Davis dragster) were third and fourth with 8.901s, and Mandy Quigley and John Boyd posted 8.902s for the fifth and sixth spots on the ladder.

Torres beat Shannon Chennault in the first round, top qualifier Trotsky in round two, and Saturday's winner, Danny Aguayo in the third round. In the quarterfinals he beat Tom McBride, and in the semi he stopped Bobby Dye Jr. Sarah Kelso went to the final by stopping Matt Woodard in round one, Art Rebrovich in the second round, and Mike Parrino in round three. A quarterfinal breakout by Jeff Murdock sent Kelso to the final as that round winner had a bye in the semi.

The Val Torres Construction-sponsored dragster of Torres had a .027 starting line advantage over Kelso in the final, and made it payoff as he took his first association win of the season with an 8.949, 173.72 to a losing effort of 8.893, 169.91 for Kelso.

With four races remaining on the '08 schedule, Chris Forsyth holds the series lead with 378 points, followed by Mandy Quigley with 368, and Bobby Dye Jr., at 340. The Gallio Motorsports Top Qualifier points chase has Quigley leading with 575 points, George Garbiso has 450 and John Richardson is third

with 435.

The next race is scheduled for September 20-21 at Auto Club Famoso Raceway, followed by the series finals at Auto Club Dragway Fontana on October 11-12.
